NEXT STEPS

- **1. Set the CTH Firewise boundary**: DONE we are using the CTH NRG boundary.
- 2. Prepare a written wildfire risk assessment: WORK-IN-PROGRESS. The assessment must be a community-wide view that identifies areas of successful wildfire risk reduction and areas where improvements could be made. Emphasis should be on the general conditions of homes and related home ignition zones. ZCs and BCs are doing the risk assessments COMPLETION DEADLINE date is May 1st. - **3.** Connor will outline the CTH NRG Firewise action plan—WORK-IN-PROGRESS—by making a prioritized list of risk reduction projects and investments for the CTH Firewise site, along with suggested homeowner actions and education activities that participants will strive to complete annually, or over a period of multiple years. The CTH action plan should be updated at a minimum of at least every three years.
- **4. Community outreach events—TO BE DETERMINED.** Goal: work with neighbors to address items in the action plan. These efforts will go towards our site's annual wildfire risk reduction investment. Find examples (PDF) of activities that count towards our investment. Use the volunteer hourly worksheet (PDF) to collect information from residents in our community.
- **5. The application**: Connor and Leslie, with help from the ZCs, will complete the application—WORK-IN-PROGRESS. Firewise USA® program management portal | Login to the portal to start your application. Note: an account has been created: ID: CTH FIREWISE | Passcode: 'CTHfirewise123!!' Connor will outline for Firewise the actions and efforts taken by CTH NRG in the community to engage residents and complete mitigation work at the home level. Once all the criteria have been completed, the electronic application can be submitted.

Becoming a Firewise USA® site

- 1. Organize it: DONE. We formed a board (a CTH NRG sub-committee) that's comprised of the CTH NRG Steering Committee). We need to consider inviting the local fire department, state forestry agency, elected officials, emergency manager, and if applicable, any apartment property management companies to participate. This group has identified the site's boundary and size.
- 2. Plan it: WORK-IN-PROGRESS. ZCs and BCs are completing a written wildfire risk assessment. The assessment is a community-wide view that identifies areas of successful wildfire risk reduction and areas where improvements could be made. Emphasis is on the general conditions of homes and related home ignition zones. The assessment is a living document and needs to be updated every five years. Contact your state liaison to learn more about the requirements. Use the Firewise USA template. (PDF)The board/sub-committee is developing the CTH action plan-a prioritized list of risk reduction projects/investments for the participating site, along with suggested homeowner actions and education activities that participants will strive to complete annually, or over a period of multiple years. Action plans will be updated at a minimum of at least every three years.
- 3. Do it: WORK-IN-PROGRESS. We need to plan to host one or more outreach events to work with neighbors on addressing items in the action plan. These efforts will go towards your site's annual wildfire risk reduction investment. Find examples (PDF) of activities that count towards your investment. Use the volunteer hourly worksheet (PDF) to collect information from residents in your community. At a minimum, each site is required to annually invest the equivalent of one volunteer hour per dwelling unit in wildfire risk reduction actions. If your site has identified 100 homes within its boundary, than 100 hours of work or the monetary equivalent, based on the independent sector value of volunteer time, need to be completed for that year.
- **4. Tell us about it: WORK-IN-PROGRESS**—our application will be completed online at <u>portal.firewise.org</u> by Connor. Once all the criteria have been completed, the electronic application will be submitted. Firewise USA® program management portal. **Questions?** Contact the Firewise® team.
